Interactive meta-documentary that aims to reflect on the interactive documentary genre. This project aims to gain a deeper understanding of this new documentary genre as we are now in the right historical period to reflect more deeply on it. This initiative is based on the hypothesis that the interactive documentary is a new audiovisual genre with specific features. The project is founded in extensive research carried out from 2007 to 2012. The doctoral dissertation involved six interactive nonfiction case studies , which made up the second stage of the project. In the third phase, the theoretical information gathered during the research period – the content – and the experience acquired from designing interfaces – the form – were combined to form this final project.

The first part of the project consists of a linear documentary with non-linear expansion that complements and enriches the traditional view, and two extra sections that make it possible to search by topics and experts. The second part of the project also includes the installation of the interactive documentary, and can be used in events. Tactile screens are used to follow a journey consisting of ten main questions and the answers of the top ten experts in this specific area.
